SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Officers were dispatched to a call of two males fighting at a gas station. The investigation revealed it was over a child exchange and the two fighting were the child's father and the new boyfriend. After the initial fist fight one male retrieved a knife and stabbed the the other male's vehicle tire. The male then tried to attack the other male with the knife prior to police arriving. The suspect with the knife was arrested for assault with a deadly weapon and

vandalism. He was booked. Officers also responded to a disturbance that involved a restraining order violation. The adult son was restrained from his elderly mother. During the incident the male began shoving his mother around. He was arrested and booked for violating the court order and elder abuse.
